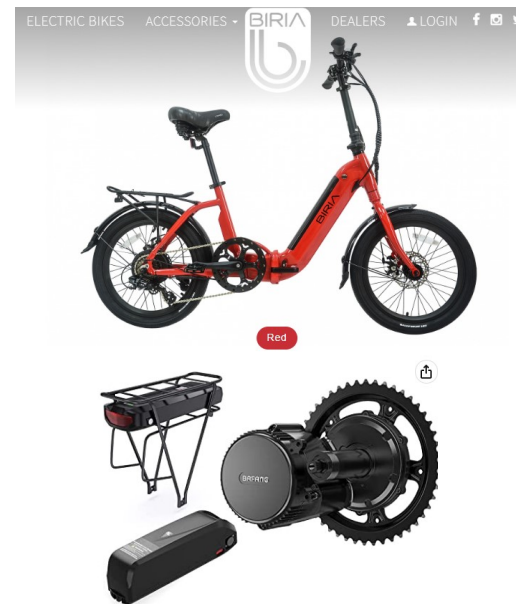
**EDUCATION NIGHT**

**Electric Bicycles**

**SPEAKER: FRED BAUER**

Because electric bikes are less physically demanding on joints and muscles, they not only bring in riders who might otherwise be inactive, but they also offer the opportunity for people to ride longer periods of time and go greater distances.

Fred Bauer is the manager of Bicycle Village in Saginaw. Fred will be discussing the different styles of E Bikes and all of the options available, from the pedal assist to a fully electric powered mode. There will be examples of the E Bikes so that you can get a hands-on, up-close look at some of the models available. He will also be discussing the Electric Bike Conversion Kits that are prepackaged sets of components designed to fit on a normal bike and convert it into an Electric Bike. These kits make it easier for end-users to find compatible, functioning parts and purchase them all together.
